Documents	
<b>Passport</b> - Copy of <u>all of the pages</u> of the Passport (valid for 6 months or longer);	
<b>I-94</b> - Copy of recent I-94, Arrival/Departure Record, <u>front and back side</u> ;	
Proof of your legal stay in the United States, which includes approvals of all your H-1B, F-1 / I-20s B-1/B-2, and H-4 etc.	
<b>EAD</b> - Copy of Employment Authorization Document (i.e., from practical training while on F-1 status), if applicable;	
<b>Current employment letter</b> if with employer petitioning your I-485	For employment based cases
<b>Tax Returns and W-2s for most current year; Last 6 months paystubs</b> - This is used to prove maintenance of status	For employment based cases
<b>Birth Certificate</b> for each applicant (Ask Attorney to check the reciprocity table)	
<b>Medical Examination</b> including immunizations in a <u>sealed envelope</u> ; For USCIS approved civil surgeon near your area, please visit: <a href="https://egov.uscis.gov/crisgwi/go?action=offices.type&amp;OfficeLocator.office_type=CIV">https://egov.uscis.gov/crisgwi/go?action=offices.type&amp;OfficeLocator.office_type=CIV</a>	
<b>Marriage Certificate</b> , if applicable;	
<b>Divorce or death certificate</b> , if applicable;	
<b>Eight (8) full-face, passport style color photographs</b> from applicant.
